
Thus, Rev. Fr. Paul Jacome welcomed us in last Feast Sunday's Mass, celebrating the beginning of the Advent Season, page 34.

And what do you know, it's already December! Time flies. Merry Christmas!


But, of course, as Catholics, we first go through Advent season.


So, brace yourself for our Grand Feast today. But before that, let me prep up a little more.

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Testimony



SIS. MARIZ PAMAONG on video:

I was living a double life then. I was part of a workplace where temptations were all around. I was a smoker for seven years. Name it, I was into it: beer, barkada, and vices.

I have a broken family. So, I looked for love from different places, from different men, and from different forms of entertainment.

I was in a relationship with a married man. I was not proud of it. Because I was already a Feast servant then.

At that time, whenever I was onstage, there was this nagging feeling from the enemy: "You're worshipping, but outside The Feast, you are a mistress."

I stayed for six months in that relationship. I thought that I would be stuck in that relationship. I thought that it was my worth.

In November 2018, I was brokenhearted. I was at my rock-bottom when I met God. I met Him in my room. I was praying for Him to remove anything that's not from Him. I cried myself to sleep.

When I woke up, I received this message from a co-Feaster: "Mhadz, would you like to attend the Kerygma Conference (now named Feast Conference)? I have an extra ticket."

Of course, I said *Yes*. I was like, if that's the only way for me to divert my attention from my woes, then I would join the Conference.

So, I attended. And there I heard this message which I felt was meant directly for me.

In the class led by Fr. Dave Concepcion, he said, "Someone here needs this message: God has to break your heart to save your soul."

I went out of that class. I called my boyfriend and I told him, "I need to stop this. I love you-- but I love God more."

How was I convinced that God is true? Every day, God would remind me that I am no longer a mistress but I'm already His princess. Because of His grace, I learned to forgive my family and myself for what I had done.

God is good. He orchestrated everything-- from the Kergyma Conference ticket given to me, to my surrendering my life to Him, to my co-Light Group member giving me a *Didache*, to being gifted with a Bible as a Christmas gift.

Since then, I decided to focus on my spiritual growth. I wanted to know God more. His goodness manifested in the people around me. I'm so grateful to The Feast and to the friends He has brought me. This is a wonderful journey that I'd like to share. Light Group is a gift. The Feast is a gift. Surrendering your life to the Lord would open so many doors in your life. You would see His goodness.

BRO. RYAN CAPITULO:

This beautiful testimony exemplifies one important lesson that I'd like to share with you today. When we encounter Jesus, our lives will change forever.

To bless you even more, I'd like to call on that wonderful lady you just saw on the video to join me here onstage. Please welcome Sister Mhadz Pamaong.



Thank you, Mhadz. I honor you for your courage to share something that may have brought you shame and maybe, your loved ones as well. But we are so blessed today because you shared your faith journey with us.

I just have a few questions.

There may be some here who are still distant from God since they are just starting on their faith journey. How would you introduce God to them? What would you tell them about the Lord that you encountered.

SIS. MHADZ: I believe that God is not someone you can move away from. There's nowhere you can go that is away from His presence. But you can feel far from God.

In my case, I felt far from God because of my sin. I gave so much authority in the flesh that it gave me depression, guilt, and shame. I carried that for a very long time. But I praise God because when I was unfaithful, He remained faithful to me.

My message to those who feel the same thing, please know that there is still hope. It always starts with going back to Jesus and to His Word.

I believe that the same grace that is meant to give us faith is the same grace that will help us go back to God.

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BRO. RYAN: For many of us here, you are our hope today. Since you shared your story today, you gave hope to many people. Again, thank you for that.


I like what you said, "God is relentless."

My second question: There may be some here who are doubting their faith. How will you encourage them to have faith in God?

SIS. MHADZ: Doubt is already part of our lives. That's the first temptation of the Devil. In Genesis 3, the Devil kept asking, "Did God really say that?"

I believe that in my faith journey, in my walk with Christ, I have encountered God telling me that He has been so gentle, compassionate, and patient to those who struggle with their beliefs.



Praise God for this Community because The Feast is a gatherinthat you can join and the people here don't do doubt-shaming. I have these extremely wonderful ladies in my Light Group. We are being vulnerable with our weaknesses.

Another what I hold on to is Matthew 17: Ask and it'll be given to you. Seek and you shall find. Knock and it'll be opened to you.

If we keep pressing on and if we keep seeking God, it'll be given to us, it'll be opened to us. Praise God for that.

BRO. RYAN: I agree with you that God is very patient.

Friends, if you will be forgiven and accepted again, stay here in The Feast because we will accept you again. We will never get tired of accepting you because we are inspired by what God is doing in our lives. God gives us so many chances. So, please, get rid of your doubts.

Mhadz, my last question: If someone may take home only one important lesson from your message, what will it be?

SIS. MHADZ: I would echo what Bro. Bo Sanchez said last FEAST CONFERENCE: God is in your mess.

I have learned that if we cooperate with God's grace, He can turn our mess into a message. The only reason I can stand here is God did not see me for who I was-- but who I could become.

BRO. RYAN: I assure you that you have blessed so many here. You are that hope that many people were waiting for today. Thank you, Mhadz.

Talk



BRO. RYAN CAPITULO:

Truly, the testimony of Mhadz exemplifies our message. We are comforted by the grace that God has given Mhadz. That was a difficult situation to be in. But isn't it comforting that God embraces everyone?

You might have thought you will remain in your rock-bottom. You thought you're too far away from God. You thought there's no hope for you.



But I'm telling you that God will meet you where you are. He *will*. Because God met Mhadz at the lowest point of her life, at the most embarrassing moment of her life. God met Mhadz when she was too embarrassed to admit what she was doing. God met Mhadz when she felt so unworthy.

And that's what God is doing to each and every one of us. We have to believe it because it's true.

I'll be giving you a summary of Talk 10 of our series *COME and SEE* because we were not able to take it up on November 17, 2024, when we did not hold our Feast due to the weather forecast that Super Typhoon Pepito would hit Metro Manila on that day.

We are still studying the *Book of St. John*. Talk 10 is titled *Resurrection*. And the big message of Talk 10 is *Jesus Knows Your Name*.





The Call

St. John started the *Resurrection* story with Mary Magdalene going to the tomb of Jesus. She was shocked

because Jesus' body was not in the tomb. She was distraught, she started to cry> "AND AS SHE WEPT, SHE BENT OVER INTO THE TOMB

"AND SAW TWO ANGELS IN WHITE SITTING THERE,
ONE AT THE HEAD AND ONE AT THE FEET WHERE THE BODY
OF JESUS HAD BEEN. "3 AND THEY SAID TO HER, "WOMAN, WHY
ARE YOU WEEPING?" SHE SAID TO THEM, "THEY HAVE TAKEN
MY LORD, AND I DON'T KNOW WHERE THEY LAID HIM."

This is a beautiful image written by St. John. We've seen this image. Where in the Bible did we see two angels? It was in the Ark of the Covenant.

(The Ark is a gold-plated wooden chest where the Ten Commandments God gave to Moses was kept. The *covenant* refers to the Mosaic Covenant, a contract formed between Yahweh and Moses

in *Exodus* and resulted in the Ten Commandments which the Ark carrieshttps://www.google.com/search?q=ark+of+the+covenant)

There are two angels guarding the Ark of the Covenant which is the most powerful symbol of God's Presence for the Israelites.

St. John was telling us a very important lesson: That Jesus is God's Presence and Jesus is the Ark of the New Covenant that God made with His people.

We also saw two images of angels guarding the Garden of Eden when Adam and Eve were expelled.

From this imagery, St. John is telling us that Jesus is the New Garden of Eden.

Jesus is the New Tree of Life, and that the gate of the Garden is no longer closed.

We also read in that particular Reading that Mary Magdalene mistook Jesus as a gardener.

Double Life

Twenty years ago, in 2004, I heard Jesus call my name. I was reading the very first book of Bro. Bo, *Thank God, He's Boss*.

I can't remember anymore how I got hold a copy of that book. While I was reading that beautiful book, God called me by name and He told me to attend The Feast. I attended for the first time at The Feast in Teatro Aguinaldo, in Murphy, Quezon City.



Oh, my, I just revealed my age. I was 31 then. I'm 51 years old now.

Instantaneously, I was drawn to The Feast. I was inspired and I was moved to be part of the Light of Jesus Family and to serve God there.

But there were complications. Back then, I was a practicing gay.

How was it possible? I wanted to keep on *practicing*. I had long hair then.


But God's call is very personal. He won't give up on us.

He continued to plant the grace that I needed to change. I had to turn away from that lifestyle. But it was hard. Initially, I resisted. I wanted to keep my *long hair*.

But God is relentless. He gave me the grace to strive to live a life of chastity and sexual purity. He allowed me to meet people who helped me along my journey. It was hard because I was already serving at The Feast-- but I kept on falling back into my old lifestyle.

I had to confess again. I had to start from zero to go through my faith journey again. I had a lot of spiritual directors. I went through a deliverance session. I attended many support groups like Courage Philippines.

After two years of falling into sin, repenting, and then falling again, and starting again, I finally received Divine Grace. The Lord gave me the grace to live in chastity and sexual purity. I've been chaste since February 1, 2006.



But mind you, I continue to struggle until now and I totally rely on His grace.

I've also realized that God is also asking us to do something for Him.

He wants you to live your life in such a way that you bring people to Jesus. Bro. Bo suggested that I join the Unfailing Love Light Group.

It's named as such because it's only the unfailing love of God that helps us overcome our burdens. As I struggled with homosexuality and same sex attraction, I started joining that Light Group which included LGBTs (all sexualities). All of us are on different stages of our faith journey.

Some question the intent of this Light Group. I would be criticized why we accept LGBTs. I tell them that I do accept them because I was once like them.

Encounter

When the Apostles encountered the resurrected Jesus, I bet they were truly happy. But Thomas was not with them. So, he could not believe that they saw Jesus:

JOHN 20:25 NABRE

"SO THE OTHER DISCIPLES SAID TO HIM, "WE HAVE SEEN THE LORD." BUT HE SAID TO THEM, "UNLESS I SEE THE MARK OF THE NAILS IN HIS HANDS AND PUT MY FINGER INTO THE NAILMARKS AND PUT MY HAND INTO HIS SIDE, I WILL NOT BELIEVE."



Thank You, Jesus, for this relationship that You're giving us right now.


My answer is "Yes!" And may my Yes be bigger every day. In the Mighty Name of Jesus, we pray.

BRO. BO SANCHEZ:

I want you to give a big, big hug to seven persons beside you and tell each one of them: "God is calling you again."

Let's give a big hand to our worship team. Thank you so much, guys.

Also, a big hand to Doc Ryan and Mhadz.

Beautiful.

Everybody say, "I'm happy!"

Tell somebody beside you, "I'm happy you're here!"

We're going to continue reading the Word of the Lord.

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Limbo

We're going to read the epilogue of *John*. This is the last talk of our series. This is the 11th talk. In the epilogue, we discovered something that's similar to *Avengers Endgame*. Its opening act is very different from the previous *Avengers* movies. The Earth's mightiest heroes were fighting alien invasion. They were doing heroic stuff.

But in the opening act of this particular movie, they were like in a limbo. They lost and they didn't know what they're supposed to do.

Captain America was leading a support group. Hulk was no longer smashing things. He was Professor Hulk. He became very gentle, and he was signing autograph for kids.











Thor, played by Chris Hemsworth, was supposed to be handsome.

But in the opening act of *Avengers Endgame*, Thor was drunk and had a fat belly.

I can almost imagine the girls saying, "Refund! We didn't come here to watch Chris Hemsworth in that way!"



Crossroad

The Avengers were lost. It's almost like what happened to the Apostles in the epilogue of *John*.

Prior to that, they were powerfully going from town to town with supernatural strength, driving out demons, performing miracles, and healing the sick. Even when they saw Jesus alive again, not all their questions were answered. They were still lost. They were still in limbo.

This is what happened:



JOHN 21:3 NIV

"I'M GOING OUT TO FISH," SIMON PETER TOLD THEM, AND THEY SAID, "WE'LL GO WITH YOU." SO THEY WENT OUT AND GOT INTO THE BOAT, BUT THAT NIGHT THEY CAUGHT NOTHING.



This was not just, "We're hungry. We need fish. We will go out."

This was Peter saying, "I don't know what I am going do. Maybe, my life for fishing for men is over. I'm going to go back to my old life and I'll start fishing again. This whole idea of giving my life to Jesus. I don't think it's for me anymore. I know Jesus rose from the dead. He's been appearing but for now I really don't know what to do with my life."

Have you been in that place? Have you been in that crossroad where you saw great things happen and your hopes are very high? Then, some crisis happened and you lost your way. Your down in the dumps. You're discouraged and frustrated.

You're asking, "What's next?"
That's the emotional state of Peter.

1. Four Steps to Renewal

When you feel like giving up on your calling, I want you to take these four steps:

1. Remember your conversion.

"EARLY IN THE MORNING, JESUS STOOD ON THE SHORE,
BUT THE DISCIPLES DID NOT REALIZE THAT IT WAS JESUS.

HE CALLED OUT TO THEM, 'FRIENDS, HAVEN'T YOU ANY FISH?'

'NO,' THEY ANSWERED. HE SAID, 'THROW YOUR NET

ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE BOAT AND YOU WILL FIND SOME.'

WHEN THEY DID, THEY WERE UNABLE TO HAUL THE NET IN

BECAUSE OF THE LARGE NUMBER OF FISH."



Does this sound familiar? If Peter had a Facebook account, he would have his old post that he did three years ago re-appear.

He would probably say, "OMG! It's happening again."

The first time when Peter gave his life to Jesus was that time when he could not catch anything. Then Jesus appeared. Jesus gave him some instructions. There was too much fish to haul because of that.

Jesus was saying: "Peter, I know you're lost. But hear me out. Do you remember that day when you gave your life to me? Go back to that. Go back to your *Why*. I want you to recapture that."

If you're lost now, I want you to go back to that time you were smitten by the love of God.

I gave my life to the Lord when I was 12 years old. My parents brought me to this crazy prayer meeting. We were 30 strange people. I was the youngest. We were weird. But that's what changed my life.

At that time, I was thinking: "Why were these crazy people praising God in this way? Is God really a God who is happy?"

It really boggled my mind. I slowly realized that this God is real. This God is alive. This God really loves me. I heard God calling my name.

Have you heard God calling your name? Jesus wants you to remember that. When you lose your way or when you get discouraged, go back to that first day when you heard Jesus call your name.

I was 13 years old when I composed my first meditation song. It was Jesus singing to me. I just wanted to bring it out that Jesus really loves me. I wrote a very sophisticated song.

The song goes this way: "I love you. Yes, I love you. Yes, I love you..." It's I love you 16x. I keep on going back to that.

2. Remember your consolation.

I'm using an Ignatian word. St. Ignatius of Loyola would talk about consolations and desolations. Consolations are times or moments when you felt the Lord.

It is your Jesus is walking on the water moments.

"THEN THE DISCIPLE WHOM JESUS LOVED SAID TO PETER,
"IT IS THE LORD!" AS SOON AS SIMON PETER HEARD HIM SAY,
"IT IS THE LORD," HE WRAPPED HIS OUTER GARMENT AROUND
HIM (FOR HE HAD TAKEN IT OFF) AND JUMPED INTO THE WATER."



The *Book of John* that was written after the Gospels were written is assuming that his readers read those other stories. In the other story, Jesus was walking in the water, Peter jumps into the water to walk to Jesus.

Again, it is déjà vu. When you are frustrated and when you have doubts and you're wondering what you're going to do with your life, remember your conversion. But also remember those *God moments*, where you experience His power in a tangible way.

May I share with you one in my life that I love to remember? It happened here in PICC 41 years ago. It was not The Feast. It was the graduation of my cousin. I was about 17 years old.

I said, "Hey, since I'll be in your graduation. I'll be your photographer."

At that time, I was trying to study photography. I didn't have a camera. So, I borrowed one. It was an expensive camera. The lens was even more expensive than the camera. I was a missionary then. The value of that camera and that lens was beyond from what I could ever afford.

So, I took photos of my cousin. After the graduation, I said my congratulations and I left. I was almost outside PICC when I opened my bag and the lens was gone. I felt so afraid.

As I started walking back, I was asking myself, "How can I pay for this?" Until I felt this sudden warmth within me. This is really a miracle because I really felt God saying: "Son, I'll take care of you. Calm down. Trust me."

At that time, it was already evening. It was all dark. I really sensed God leading me to this patch of grass outside PICC. So, I started walking.

I asked myself, "Why here? Did I walk here?" I couldn't see anything but I kept on walking. I heard someone say, "Stop. Bend down."

I found the lens. That was my God moment.

When I have questions, I go back to my *God moments* -- to those moments in my life where there is no doubt that God was there.

I'm sure you have lots of *God moments*. I want you to collect those stories.

3. Repeat your Communion.

JOHN 21:8-9 NIV

THE OTHER DISCIPLES FOLLOWED IN THE BOAT, TOWING THE
NET FULL OF FISH, FOR THEY WERE NOT FAR FROM SHORE,
ABOUT A HUNDRED YARDS. 9 WHEN THEY LANDED, THEY SAW
A FIRE OF BURNING COALS THERE WITH FISH ON IT,
AND SOME BREAD."




At that time that the disciples did not have fish-- because they weren't able to catch fish the whole night-- probably they were wondering: "How are we going to eat tomorrow?"

On the other side, Jesus was already preparing the best breakfast buffet ever for them.

I want you to hold on to that.

Whenever you are lost wondering what you will do in your life, keep on going back to the rituals that Jesus Himself established.



For us Catholics, it is the Eucharist.

This was very special because the last meal that they had with Jesus was in the Last Supper. Jesus was going to break bread here with them.

I really believe that every Eucharist is a callback. Each time you go to Mass and receive Jesus--even when you don't feel like going to Mass--keep on doing it.





4. Repeat your conversation with Jesus.

"WHEN THEY HAD FINISHED EATING, JESUS SAID TO SIMON PETER,
'SIMON SON OF JOHN, DO YOU LOVE ME MORE THAN THESE?'
'YES, LORD,' HE SAID, 'YOU KNOW THAT I LOVE YOU.' JESUS SAID,
'FEED MY LAMBS.' '6 AGAIN JESUS SAID, 'SIMON SON OF JOHN,
DO YOU LOVE ME?' HE ANSWERED, 'YES, LORD, YOU KNOW THAT
I LOVE YOU.' JESUS SAID, 'TAKE CARE OF MY SHEEP.'

We preached this before and I'm going to remind you why we are preaching about that. This verse is in English.

This was written originally in Greek. In Greek, there are different words for love. Let me put in front of you how the conversation went. Greek words of *love* used in this passage are *agape* and *philia*.

Agape is perfect love or divine love. Philia is friendship -- great love but not perfect. It's the human love. In place of love, let's use agape and philia:>

Peter is no longer the loud, boastful and impulsive guy who says, "Jesus, I will die for you."

He has humbled. He has gone through denying himself three times in front of a maid. He knows that he is made of brittle stuff. He's weak.

Peter cannot say, "Jesus, I *agape* You." Jesus asked Peter, "Do you *philia* me?" Jesus goes down to his level.

You know your weaknesses. Let's give to God the small that we have. Let's give to the Lord *what* we are and *who* we are and bring us to the Presence of the Lord.

And let Him be the one to say: "I will meet you where you are. I will go to your weakness. I will go to your questions. I will go to your doubts. If you still have doubts following me, it's okay. Just come. If you don't feel like praying, just pray. If you don't feel like reading the Bible, just read the Bible. If you don't feel like going to The Feast, go there every week-- because I'm going to meet you where you are."

Present to Him your doubts, questions, and confusion. Present to Him your mistakes, failures, hurts, and wounds. From every part of this congregation, give them to the Lord. He calls you by name. Jesus embraces you, as is, where is. He will heal what needs to be healed. He will touch what needs to be touched. And he will walk with you in this journey.

God is calling you back. Jesus is calling you back. Do you hear Him? Do you hear Him calling your name? He's calling you: "Come back. Come back to me."

BRO. LEP SUMERA:

Praise, God, in Your faithfulness.

Thank You, Jesus, that you continue to call us.

There's so much take away from our Grand Feast.

I would like to believe that as God calls us by name, there is that Light that the Lord is shining to us and giving us that clarity. And I guess it's important in this broken world. There's so much branding, labels, identities.



So, I need you to convince the person beside you, "You are God's Light." We show you a video about this group shining God's light in this area:







BRO. LEP SUMERA:

Friends, please join me in welcoming Bro. Alo Gelano, chairman of Jesus Christ Cares for Cancer (JCCFC) and Sis. Maritess Cordero, board secretary.

BRO. ALO GELANO:

Thank you very much, Bro. Lep. Thank you to Bro. Bo, Bro. Alvin, and Bro. Audee. And to everybody here in The Feast.

BRO. LEP: Bro. Alo, what is the purpose JCCFC? When did it start?

BRO. ALO: JCCFC is a cancer foundation. But we don't really dabble on the medical. Our foundation is a cash-aid foundation. You know, cancer is one of the most expensive sickness, one of the most dangerous to a person's life.

And for us, giving a bit of cash will help alleviate the patient's burden.

So, our mission is to just alleviate the suffering of the patients. And, of course, we pray that they get well. But let's face it, it's not a perfect science. We don't know if somebody will get well or not.

But we do know, we can help, even just a bit.

SIS. MARITESS: JCCFC started September 28, 2015. So, our Foundation recently celebrated its ninth anniversary.







BRO. ALO: This Foundation was established by Bro. Rey Ortega (*left*), a member of The Feast. He passed away in 2017 and he gave us this legacy.

BRO. LEP: If someone here is interested to help out or be a beneficiary of the Foundation, how may they?

SIS. MARITESS: JCCFC ministers to indigent patients—the poorest of the poor. There are two criteria: 1. the patients are undergoing treatment (not those already in remission); and 2. they really have financial need.

Somehow, the cash aid enables them to buy food.

Please message us through our Facebook page: Jesus Christ Cares for Cancer.

BRO. ALO: Our target beneficiaries are not only the poorest of the poor but also those who are afflicted with the highest level of cancer-- already in Stage 4, terminal case. We have cases with very high mortality rate.

SIS. MARITESS: Just last November, we lost a four-year-old boy to leukemia. This year, we lost more than 12 beneficiaries.

But we do have miracle healings. We have here, afflicted with Stage 3 breast cancer. Now, she's serving with us as a volunteer.

BRO. ALO: We want to give them not only cash. We want the Lord to touch them. That's why we bring them to places like The Feast for spiritual nourishment.

Our Foundation lives only through donations and so, we seek help from everybody for us to be of help to the least of our brethren.

BRO. LEP: You know what? My dad is a cancer survivor. He was a fighter of cancer for seven years. That's why when I found out about this Ministry, I was like, "Why did I found out just now? Because I'm telling you, when cancer hits, not only the patient suffers but the entire family as well. We were drained-financially, emotionally, and even spiritually.

So, I'm happy with what JCCFC is doing, and now they are here to ask for our help, that we, too, may become part of the Light that they are shining to those in need. If the Lord is speaking to you today, calling you by your name, asking you to be generous, they have a table outside and they will be waiting for your love to be extended to the needy.





BRO. LEP: Final question: You have a monthly gathering. What do you do in that gathering?

BRO. ALO: Like I said, we try to give our beneficiaries spiritual nourishment. So, in our Assembly, we have a Mass.

Not only for the patients but for their family as well. They can't attend Mass because they are stuck in the hospital taking care of their sick member.

We also invite speakers like Bro. Bo and Bro. Alvin to give inspirational messages to them.

We asked for this opportunity to appeal to you because, if I may be bold to reveal, our fund now can sustain the cash-aid program for only eight months. So, we appeal for your help. We're legit. on the Gospel Mark 12:38-44

Excerpts: Good Morning!

If it's not too much to ask,

say to the person beside you: "I am blessed because I'm beside you."

We have entered the season of Advent.

You're probably wearing why the priests are wearing the violet chasubles.

If you noticed, we didn't sing *The Gloria*.

We toned down our decorations. There are no flowers-- only leaves. This is to somehow condition us that we are entering a season of preparation. We need not use many decorations and trivialities. We must focus on Someone who is to come.

The word *advent* came from the Latin word, *adventus*.

I'll give you another trivia.

The word *adventure* came from the Latin word, *adventuros*. These two words have the same root word which is *ad venire* which means *something that which is to come*.

Advent Journey

If we will look deeper, we can say,

"Welcome to our ADVENTure.

Welcome to our ADVENTture with God."

Even though this is a long period of waiting and preparing, take hold into your heart that God has something in store for you.

We are now in Advent. Soon, it will be Christmas. You might feel that it seems we're just going in a circular motion.

But my dear Friends, it isn't like that.

We are not going circular-- we are going deeper.

Have you seen a screwdriver? How about a screw? When you use a screwdriver, it seems it is going circular. But if you will look closer, you'll see it's going deeper.

It's just like our *ADVENT* ture -- going deeper in God, with God, and always through God.

How can we traverse this path of journeying with the Lord?

The Readings for today invite us to somehow have handles:

1.Promise

Our God is the God of Fulfilled Promises. If you listened intently, you would have noticed the First Reading says: "The days are coming," declares the LORD, "when I will make a new covenant with the people of Israel and with the people of Judah."

The Lord was also the One who told us in the book of the Prophet Isaiah: "When the time is right, I, the Lord, will make it happen."

I hope you bring those promises with you. Let us claim them in the Name of the Lord. He will fulfill His promise.



First Reading: Jeremiah 33:14-16

14 The days are coming, says the Lord, when I will fulfill the promise I made to the house of Israel and Judah.
15 In those days, in that time, I will raise up for David a just shoot; he shall do what is right and just in the land.
16 In those days Judah shall be safe and Jerusalem shall dwell secure; this is what they shall call her:
"The Lord our justice."





Advent Wreath Candle 1: Hope

We have a beautiful Catholic tradition.

We light the candles on the Advent Wreath. The first candle is the Candle of Hope. Every time we light it and see that flickering of light, it's as if we are saying that no matter how long the night of waiting is, the dawn upon high will always break upon us.

The Lord will come and He will meet us where we are.

But remember: the Lord will meet us where we are but He will not leave us where He found us. He will always lead us to the Father.

That's why our hope is not a mere positivity. When we speak of hope, our hope has a face, our hope has a name: Jesus. When we speak of that hope, we are resting and trusting in God's loving providence. He will fulfill His promise because our God is the God of Fulfilled Promises.



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2. New Beginnings

Our God is not only the God of Fulfilled Promises but also the God of New Beginnings.

In the Catholic Church, as we enter the Advent season, we are also entering another liturgical calendar. So, you may greet each other "Happy New Year!"

It is a new year for all of us. If you notice, I am wearing purple or violet and it is characteristic of penance. A calling to return.

That is why that even though we are entering a new season, we are called and reminded to avail ourselves of the Sacrament of Reconciliation. After this Mass, you may want to avail yourself of the Sacrament.

We are not only preparing physically; we must also prepare internally. In this season, it's as if God is telling you: "Begin again-- but this time, do it with me."

Sometimes, we are too busy trying to put up a facade that we can do it alone, that we can do it without God.

But He is telling you today: "Do it with me."

I remember a lesson from my formator. I asked him, "Why is it sometimes, it seems that I cannot bring others closer to God when I tell them my stories or my personal conviction?"

He told me, "Sometimes, you're too busy letting other people know that you are strong. You forget to let other people feel your warmth."

That is the disposition we will have when we do it with God. People will know because we can never feign goodness.

3. Hearts

Our God is not only the God of Fulfilled Promises and the God of New Beginnings. He is also the God of our Hearts.

You have heard in the Second Reading: "May the Lord increase and abound in love for one another so as to strengthen your hearts."

The word *courage* came from the Latin word *Cor cordis* which means *Heart of hearts*.

Every time you will hear the Lord from the Scriptures saying, "Take courage. It is I,"

note that He is telling you to bring your heart to Him -- for it to be strengthened.

He also said, "Beware that your hearts do not become drowsing and carousing in drunkenness and be drowned by the anxieties of life."

On the second part, He told us, "Be vigilant at all times. Pray that you may have the strength."

Why? Because even the strength that we hope to bear is not even ours to begin with. Strength is grace from God.

My dear Friend, bring your heart to the One who will strengthen it-- and it's not other than the Lord.

We do not learn to fly by becoming fearless but by daily practice of courage. Courage is just Fear that learned how to say its prayers.

As we traverse this wonderful Advent journey, remember that God will fulfill His promise, He will give you a new life and He will always strengthen your heart. Amen.



Second Reading: Luke 21:25-28, 34-36

12 Brothers and sisters: May the Lord make you increase and abound in love for one another and for all, just as we have for you, 13 so as to strengthen your hearts, to be blameless in holiness before our God and Father at the coming of our Lord Jesus with all his holy ones. Amen. 4:1 Finally, brothers and sisters, we earnestly ask and exhort you in the Lord Jesus that, as you received from us how you should conduct yourselves

to please God—and as you are conducting yourselves—you do so even more. 2 For you know what instructions we gave you through the Lord Jesus.


